### Autonomous Vehicle Specialist

## Job Description

Autonomous Vehicle Specialist will be responsible for designing, developing, and maintaining autonomous vehicles. Daily tasks include troubleshooting automation issues, implementing process control systems, and working with robotics and electrical engineering components.

## Relevant Education / Pathways

- Bachelor's degree in Robotics, Computer Science, Electrical Engineering, or a related field.
- Valid driver's license (3+ years clean record).
- Proven experience in AD testing, automotive/multimedia testing, or related QA work.

## Required Skills & Competencies

- Experience with ROS, CAN bus tools (e.g., CANalyzer), or drive-by-wire systems.
- Prior work in robotics, HIL/SIL testing, or hardware-in-the-loop environments.
- Experience with autonomous vehicles or vehicle testing is a plus.
- Background in defensive driving.

## Key Tasks / Responsibilities

- Safe Vehicle Operation & Real-Time Oversight
- Drive or supervise autonomous vehicles, taking over control when needed.
- Conduct pre-/post-shift vehicle checks and ensure all test equipment is operational.
- Test Execution & Data Integrity
- Run scripted and exploratory test scenarios (urban, closed-site, edge cases).
- First-Line Debug & Reporting
- Reproduce issues, capture repro steps, and summarize findings in the defect-tracking system.
- Contribute to test-case reviews and process-improvement sessions.

### Environmental Engineer

## Job Description

In this role, you will engage in various fieldwork activities and prepare comprehensive reports related to site assessments, pilot tests, remediation system construction, operations and maintenance, natural attenuation monitoring, and well abandonments. You will be responsible for sampling soil, groundwater, and surface water. Additionally you will prepare scopes of work and cost estimates, and maintain effective communication with coworkers, regulators, and clients.

## Relevant Education / Pathways

- At least a bachelor's degree in Civil, Environmental, or Chemical Engineering.
- 0-2 years of experience in environmental engineer or consulting.
- Willingness and ability to complete field work a plus. This can involve climbing elevated structures, descending into excavations, entering confined spaces (below ground vaults or above ground storage tanks) and being in the vicinity of heavy construction equipment and vehicles is a plus.

- Expertise in remediation, assessment, and regulatory compliance.
- Field sampling skills for soil, groundwater, and surface water.
- Technical writing abilities for detailed environmental reports.
- Regulatory knowledge.
- Project management skills including subcontractor oversight and cost estimation.

- Conduct fieldwork and prepare reports for site assessments, pilot tests, and remediation system construction and operations.
- Perform soil, groundwater, and surface water sampling.

- Develop scopes of work and cost estimates for projects.
- Communicate effectively with coworkers, regulators, and clients.

## Relevant Education / Pathways

- Bachelor's degree, preferably in Business or Engineering.
- 5+ years of renewable project development, project finance, or acquisition experience.

## Required Skills & Competencies

- Financial modelling expertise using Microsoft Excel.
- Strong communication.
- Organization.
- Expertise in Renewable Energy Management.

## Key Tasks / Responsibilities

- Interface with the Land Acquisition team and lead the greenfield land campaign strategy for share purchase plan.
- Complete financial modeling and analysis necessary to advise key transactions as well as evaluate and frame project development risks and opportunities.
- Manage and own the project development work streams for wind, solar, and load projects in the SPP market through the leadership of an interdisciplinary team of subject matter experts.
- Coordinate, and maintain the interconnection study process, timeline, and relationships, along with analyses for transmission service availability, basis, and curtailment.

- A bachelor's degree in a related field (e.g., biology, public health)
- Master's degree in public health with a concentration in epidemiology
- PH.D. is often necessary for research-focused positions.

- Public health principles & knowledge of epidemiology
- Critical thinking and research skills
- Communication & interpersonal skills
- Problem-solving

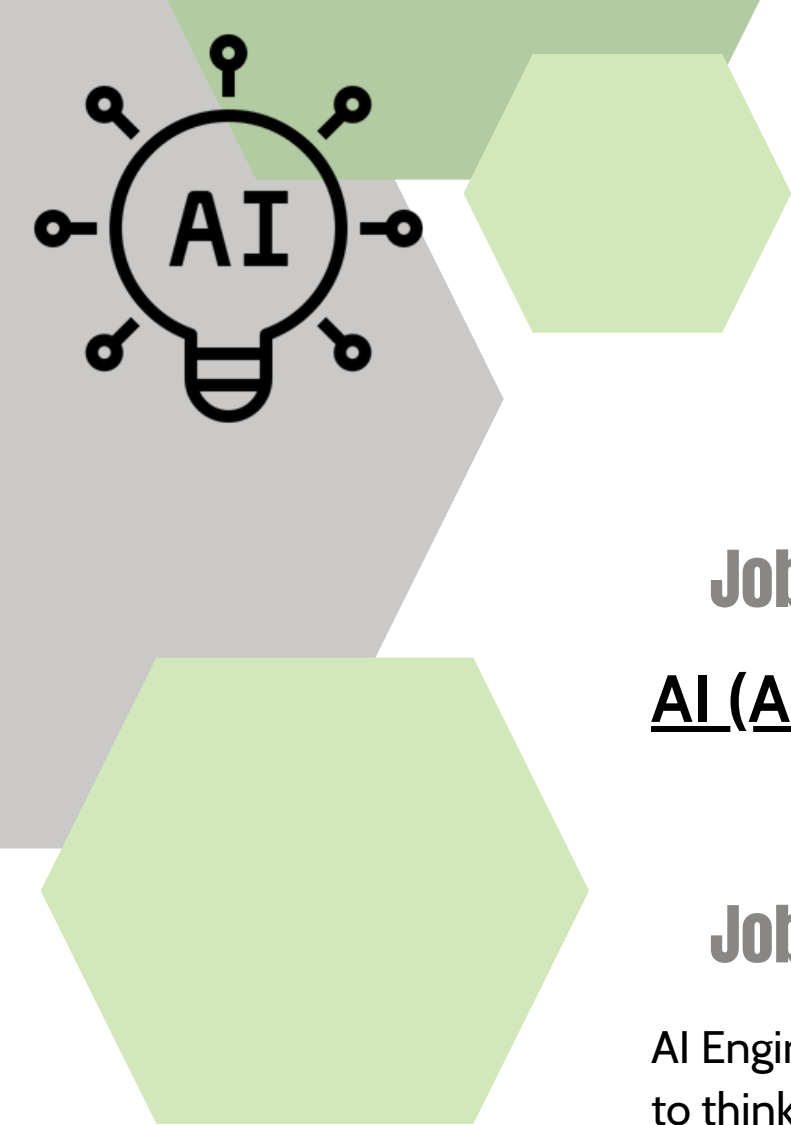

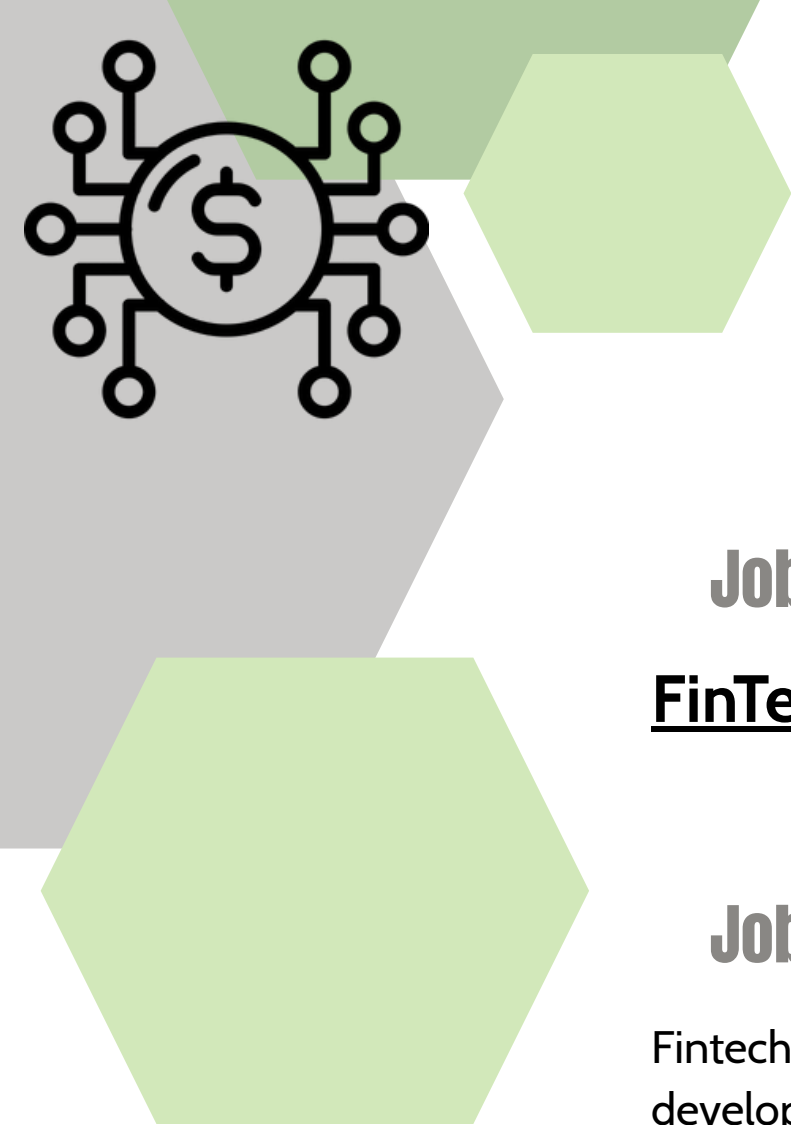

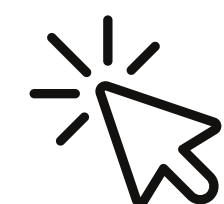
